Care proceedings – Contact – Penal notice attached – Whether penal notice could be attached to contact order in public law proceedings – Whether contact order under Children Act 1989, s 34 enforceable by committal

Care proceedings – Jurisdiction – County court acting as High Court judge in order to make use of powers under inherent jurisdiction – Procedure – Whether appropriate
